## Important Dates

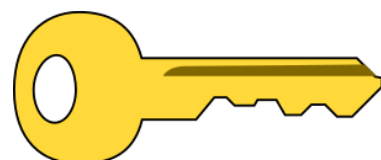


Please make sure you have a look at our important dates on the reverse of this newsletter to keep up to date with what we're doing in school. More specific information will be handed out nearer the time.
