YEAR 2: As you will be aware Mrs Yeo planned to go on maternity leave in early February. This date has been brought forward to start this week. The arrangements previously made for Mrs Bentley to work full time in Year 2 and Mrs Pemberton to work in Year 1 have come into operation.

I'm sure you join with all staff in wishing Mrs Yeo and husband all the best for the imminent arrival of their first child.

MATs (MULTI-ACADEMY TRUSTS): The government has made it clear they wish all schools to join a MAT. At the same time the Local Authority is contracting and reducing the services and support offered. Yesterday the Heads and Chairs of Governors of Lanivet/Cardinham, Berrycombe and St.Wenn met with TPAT (Truro and Penwith Academy Trust) to discuss the possibility of joining them. Should governors wish to take this further there will be a full consultation period with parents, staff and the wider community. Further information to follow.

LUNCHTIME CHOIR: There will be no lunchtime choir club due to Mrs Yeo being off but she will be coming in during the school day on certain days to practice with the choir in readiness to prepare for the concert on the 27th January which will still be going ahead as arranged.

CHOIR CONCERT: Tickets are now on sale in the school office priced at £4.00 per adult and children are free but everyone must have a ticket. We have approximately 65 tickets available. KS 1 choir will perform near the beginning of the concert enabling them to go home early. KS 2 is approximately 7.15pm—9.15pm. Children to arrive at school for 7pm. The PTA have kindly offered refreshments before the concert as there is no interval and there will also be a raffle.

PTA MEETING: The next meeting in school is scheduled for Thursday 19th January at 9.15am all welcome.

PUPIL PREMIUM

The school receives funding for children who have received free school meals within the last 6 years, have parents in the forces or are / or have been in care. Policies outlining how the school uses this money are posted on the school website.

It is worth applying for free school meals even if currently having free meals as an Infant. The benefits remain for six years after your child becomes ineligible for free school meals.

Next week a letter will be sent to parents of children for whom the school receives Pupil Premium.

If you fee you may be entitled to free school meals, please contact the office for advice.

We have been very fortunate to have the new car park available to parents and staff. The Parish Council wishes to make parking as easy as possible around the school so have made the pull-in opposite the entrance available only to taxis and disabled drivers.
