Cardinham's Race for Life

Join Cardinham Primary School on Thursday 28th September between 2-3:30pm as the children 'Race for Life'. The children from Cardinham Primary School will be toddling, walking, jogging or running set distances to raise money for Cancer Research UK. The set distances are as follows:

- Woodpecker Class and Reception: 500m ($\frac{1}{2}$ km)
- Year 1 & Year 2: 1000m (1km)
- Year 3, 4, 5 & 6: 1600m (1 mile)

If children would like to continue to run, walk, toddle or jog after their distance is complete, they can. All children should've brought a sponsorship form home today so they can head out and collect sponsors for completing their set distances - remember, any amount raised is worthwhile. After the event, please bring in any sponsorship money raised so the school can then collate the total and send off. There are consent forms that must be completed before children can enter into this event. Parents, carers and relatives - whilst you watch the event, tea, coffee, squash and cake will be able to buy and all proceeds from this will go to Macmillan Cancer support. We hope that you can come along and support this event.
