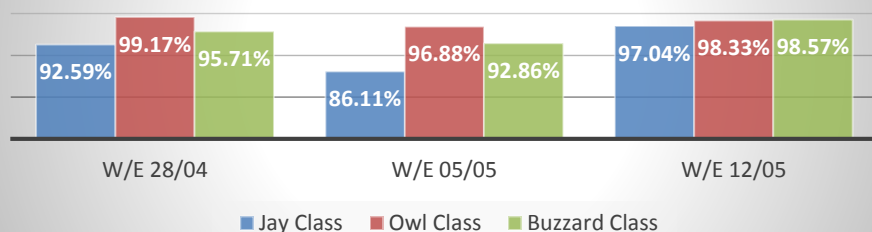

Free School Meals

All Key Stage 1 children (Reception, Year 1 and Year 2) are eligible to receive free school meals. However, if you are in receipt of one or more of the benefits listed (see below) and you do not receive Working Tax Credits, your child's school could benefit from Pupil Premium funding to support your child just by filling in a Free School Meal application form.

Qualifying Benefits

- Income support.
- Income-based jobseeker's allowance (not contribution based).
- Income-related employment & support allowance (not contribution based).
- Child Tax Credit (CTC) with an annual income of no more than £16,190.
- Guarantee element of State Pension Credit.
- Support via Part VI of the Immigration & Asylum Act 1999 (IAA)

Please note, if you are in receipt of Working Tax Credit, you do not qualify for Free School Meals, even if your annual income is below £16,190. If you have any questions, would like any more information or need guidance in completing the forms, then please see our office staff.
