## STARTING PRIMARY SCHOOL

### SEPTEMBER 2018

If your child was born between 1 September 2013 and 31 August 2014 you will need to apply for a school place for September 2018.

**The deadline for applications is 15 January 2018.** You need to apply online on the Cornwall Council website – ask in the office if you have any problems or need advice.
