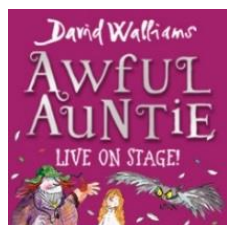

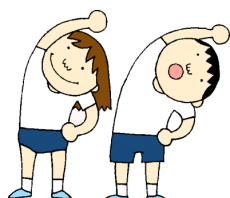


Whole School Plea: Plastic 4pint Milk Cartons
