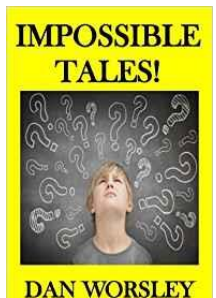
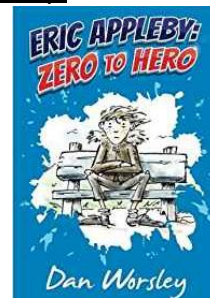

...reading takes you on adventures, allows you to meet characters and go to places that are loads more exciting than anything real life can offer.

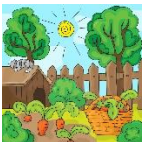


KS1 SATs Meeting for Parents

Well done and thank you Elouise and Florence, who were the youngest competitors in the entire competition! In the morning, the children were given the opportunity to practice the four events: 300m run, 50m sprint, vortex throw and standing long jump. After lunch they competed against around 200 pupils, from approximately 15 different schools in Mid-Cornwall. Cardinham looked strong throughout the afternoon with some excellent performances from the entire squad. Jasmine convincingly winning a very competitive 300m race, was a particular highlight. Matilda excelled in all four events, as did Charlie, who finished in 4th place overall. Cardinham, as a team, finished in a very impressive 3rd place; a significant achievement for such a small school! Mrs Grant and Chloe were exceptionally proud of all of the children who competed.
