**INFORMATION**—There is a possible evidence of a pupil with slapped cheek in school. This can be dangerous for pregnant women and those with a weakened immune system. The NHS guidelines are that it is a viral infection that's most commonly in children, although it can affect people of any age. It usually causes a bright red rash on the cheeks. This is normally a mild infection that clears up by itself in one to three weeks. Symptoms usually develop 4–14 days after becoming infected, but sometimes may not appear for up to 21 days. Other initial symptoms may also be a slight raised temperature, a sore throat, runny nose, headache, upset stomach, generally feeling unwell.
