BREAKFAST CLUB

has restarted This is open to all pupils at a cost of £2 per day. Breakfast will include a drink (milk, fruit juice or squash), fruit, cereal and toast with various spreads plus the occasional treat!



Children do not have to attend every day or pre-book their place they can just turn up at 8 a.m. However, (if you have not already done so), a registration form must be completed in advance. If you are interested please contact the office for a form. Please note there will be a 50p charge for children who are dropped into school at 8.30 a.m. but are not having breakfast.

We have a quantity of small **CLASSROOM TABLES** which are free to a good home. If you are interested if them (or you would just like one) then please contact the office.

SWIMMING restarts for all pupils on Monday. You will have been notified which bus your child will be travelling on—if not please contact the office. **Children travelling on the first bus should be collected at the normal time and children on the second bus at 3.40 p.m.**

May we remind parents that if it is your intention to pick your child up from the Dragon Centre then you need to let the office know. Please also let them know if this will be every week or is just a one off.

We ask for contributions for activities such as swimming or visits. Contributions go in a pot towards the cost of additional activities, however, all remain subsidised by the school. The school never makes a profit out of these contributions.

The price of SCHOOL DINNERS (pupils in years 3-6 only) has increased to £2.30 per day. Pupils purchasing four meals in one week will get the fifth one free. Vegetarian meals or jacket potatoes should be ordered from the office as these are cooked to order (pupils in class 2-6 only).

PARKING: it is good to see so many people using the car parks on the playing field and the Village Green. Can I also remind parents that the Pub and Fish & Chip Shop have also offered their car parks for dropping off and picking up; this can be very handy in ensuring a fast 'getaway'. Opposite the school there is a small pull in which has been identified by the police and Parish Council to be used for taxis and disabled parking during school hours. We would ask all parents to respect this.
