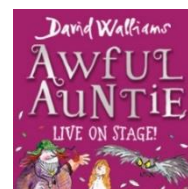
A huge thank you to Mrs Renals who provided the children with a delicious Christmas lunch yesterday!

Last week of term info

Tuesday 19th December - We are holding our school Christmas parties in the afternoon. During the day, children will play party games, they will have a special visitor and have party food for lunch. The school kitchen will provide sandwiches and sausages but we do ask that children contribute an item of food. Therefore, please can:
