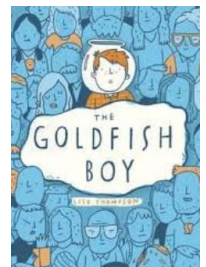

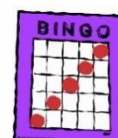


Sport Relief Fundraiser
