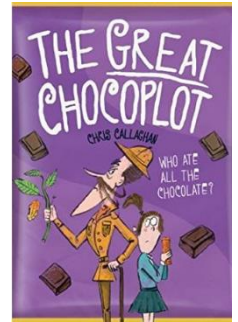

### The Daily Mile: What the Research Says



Studies at The University of Edinburgh and The University of Stirling found that after doing a run or walk activity - like the daily mile - pupils did better on attention tasks - they were also quicker at responding. Further to this, children were also better at controlling their responses after exercise, making fewer mistakes due to answering or behaving impulsively.
