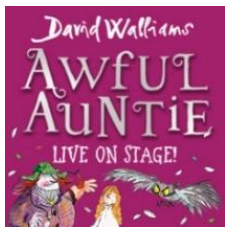
Achievement Assemblies

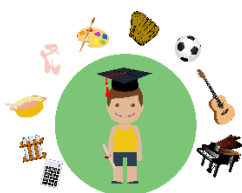
